NMMC headquarters to be disinfected on weekend

Navi Mumbai to be under lockdown for 10 days

While the city will go under yet another lockdown from the midnight of Friday, the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has decided to carry out disinfection of its headquarters in Belapur during the weekend. The disinfection of the civic headquarter building will be carried out on Saturday and Sunday.

In order to ensure the safety of staff coming to civic headquarter for work, the civic chief decided to take benefits of the weekend when there is less work. However, the COVID-19 related work will be carried out as usual from other civic buildings.

Despite a number of steps to contain the spread of coronavirus, the number of positive cases under the Navi Mumbai police commissioner crossed 10,500, over 800 positive cases reported in the last

two days. Under the NMMC, 7345 positive cases have already reported till Friday. Similarly, Panvel Gramin has 1141 positive cases and Panvel Municipal Corporation (PMC) reported around 2500 positive cases so far.

On July 3, the NMMC area saw 257 positive cases of corona positive. The active cases under the corporation are 4116. The number of active cases under the NMMC on June 11 was 1998 and it reached to 4116 on July 3.

Meanwhile, Jitendra Ahwad, minister for the housing of Maharashtra government, visited the civic headquarter on Friday to take stock of the COVID-19 situation in the city. While Ahwad discussed the preparation to fight against coronavirus with the municipal commissioner, his supporters in large numbers were seen violating the social distancing



norms. Around 60 to 70 supporters of Ahwad were present at the civic headquarter during his visit and they did not maintain the social distancing. While the civic body collected over Rs 7 lakh fines from common citizens for not following the lockdown norms, the government's representatives are seen breaking the norms at civic headquarter.

After a sudden rise in corona positive cases in Navi Mumbai, senior leaders from the government, as well as opposition, are visiting the

city. Now, former chief minister Devendra Fadnis will visit Panvel to see the preparation to fight against coronavirus. He will visit in the morning and discuss with the civic chief on how to contain positive cases.

Meanwhile, the Panvel Municipal Corporation has set up a panel to audit bills collected by private hospitals especially hospitals being run by a trust. A number of cases reported where private hospitals were seen inflating bills for the treatment of COVID patients.

Man held for killing minor daughter in Beed

A 40-year-old man was arrested for allegedly killing his minor daughter and hiding her body in a sugarcane field at a village in Maharashtra's Beed district, police said on Friday.

The police on Wednesday nabbed Prakash Kashinath Bhangre for allegedly killing his 14-year-old daughter Sheetal Dadasaheb Toge, assistant inspector Maheshkumar Tak of Wadvani police station said.

The victim, who was married and lived in Chikal Beed, went missing on June 28, and her body was recovered from a sugarcane field two days later, the official said.

Investigations revealed that the accused had killed the victim by slitting her throat and had later hid her body, he said.

A case of murder has been registered against the accused, the official added.

Karnala Nagri Sahkari scam case transferred to CID

The Rs 512.5 crore scam of Panvel-based Karnala Nagri Sahkari has been transferred from the Economic Office Wing (EOW) of the Navi Mumbai police to the Crime Investigation Department (CID), Pune. The Director-General of Police (DGP) of the state issued an order on Friday, transferring the further investigation of the case to the CID, said police.

According to a senior official of Navi Mumbai police, following the order from the DGP further investigations will be carried out by the CID.

The EoW of Navi Mumbai police had registered a case of cheating and forgery against 76 persons, including 12 bank office-bearers and the bank's chairman former MLA Vivek Patil in February this year.

The report of the special auditor of the cooperation department of Raigad named the former MLA and founder-chairman Patil as the key accused in the Rs 512.54,53,268 scam of Karnala Nagri Sahkari Bank. The other accused in the scam included 12



members of the bank's management and 64 borrowers. They allegedly misappropriated the huge amount from the cooperative bank funds on the pretext of loans.

The report submitted to the RBI by the Raigad cooperative department revealed that management of the bank including vice-chairman, CEO and board of directors overlooked the bank's rules and regulations and siphoned off bank deposits to accounts of trusts owned by their own people.

According to police, on the basis of fake documents, loans were disbursed, which were never recovered. In addition, loans were also given

to trusts which were owned by Patil.

The RBI capped the limit of withdrawal to Rs 5000 for existing account holders and also directed police to register a case. The Panvel City police registered a case in February 2020 which was later transferred to the EOW. FIR was also registered against some of the sifting corporators of PWP. They were booked under section 409, 417, 420, 463, 465, 467, 468, 471, 472, 477, 120 B and 34 of IPC and 147 of Cooperative Society Act including 3 and 4 of Protection of Interest of Depositors Act. The bank has 17 branches in Navi Mumbai, Pune, and Ratnagiri and over 40,000 depositors.

MBMC recovery rate hovers above 73%

Amid an alarming rise in the number of coronavirus cases and a gradual surge in casualties, the recovery rate in the twin-cities has been showing significant improvement.

With 150 patients being recovered from the deadly Covid-19 during the last 24 hours, the total number of patients discharged from designated hospitals has crossed the 2,500-mark to reach 2,648. Notably, 1,646 out of the recovered 2,648 patients have been discharged in less than a fortnight, pulling down the number of active cases from total of 3,609 to 812.

The bettering recovery rate and a large chunk of infected
